1708 internships are part-time (7-12 hrs./week) and unpaid, but can qualify for school credit depending on the candidate's department.

The ideal candidate is currently earning a BFA or has recently earned a BFA, is a motivated, self-starter, and has a passion for Contemporary art and the Richmond arts community.

Interns receive hands-on experience and resume-building skills in all aspects of 1708 Gallery's operations, including:

- installation and de-installation of exhibitions and artist relations
- gallery openings and receptions and event planning
- educational programs, tours, and gallery sitting
- fundraising, PR, and marketing
- archival documentation projects of exhibitions/artists/gallery history
- · non-profit gallery administration

1708 Gallery internships last approximately 5 months and typically follow college semesters - Spring (Jan. - May), Summer (May - Sept.), and Fall (Sept. - Jan.).
